

National Toggenburg Club Online Sale 4/25/25



WHAT:

An online sale for members of the National Toggenburg Club (NTC) to showcase their breeding programs and support the growth of the Toggenburg breed. The online auction will be held on SOnline on April 25, 2026.

WHO:

The National Toggenburg Club Online Sale is open **only** to NTC members in good standing for consignments. Only Toggenburg animals are eligible, including American, Purebred, and Recorded Grade/Experimental Toggenburgs. Eligible animals include doe kids, dry yearlings, mature milkers, buck kids, and adult bucks, provided all selection criteria are met. Each member can nominate up to 3 animals.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Animals consigned must be of the highest quality, with the majority of consignments being does. Doe kids, dry yearlings, and milkers are of nomination eligibility. Mature bucks and buck kids may be nominated; however, male animals will be heavily scrutinized. The ratio of bucks to does accepted into the sale will not exceed 1 buck to 4 does.

Selection will be based on genetic potential, structural correctness, and, when available, show accolades and performance program data of the animal or its relatives. All nominations must be completed through the Google Form on the NTC website. Nominations will **close April 15**.

Acceptance into the sale will occur on a rolling basis. The **sooner** you get your nominations submitted, the more time you will have as the consignor to advertise (pending acceptance into the sale).

DISCLAIMERS:

Each animal is sold under the individual consigning herd and is subject to that herd's specific health standards and animal-rearing practices. Buyers are encouraged to review each herd's sales policies and health standards prior to purchasing. The NTC is not responsible for individual transactions or health records.

It is the responsibility of each consignor to promote their animals through their own channels. The NTC will make reasonable efforts to help coordinate or publish transport routes; however, scheduling pickup of purchased animals is the responsibility of the buyer and seller.

COMMISSION SPLITS:

SOnline will retain a 5% commission on each animal sold, plus a \$25 listing fee. The National Toggenburg Club will retain an additional 5% commission. These funds will be allocated to establish the NTC Youth Grant Program.

Example:

If an animal sells for \$1,000:

- SOnline receives \$75
- NTC receives \$50
- Seller receives \$875
